

This is what we do:

Level:

1. Note any damage to body or upholstery
2. Check horn operation and tone
3. Carry out battery/alternator test
4. Check operation of lights
5. Check condition of wiper blades
6. Test screen wash operation, adjust/top up and add screen wash
7. Visually inspect cooling system and test antifreeze strength
8. Inspect condition of alternator and PAS bolts
9. Inspect brake fluid levels
10. Examine condition of exhaust and mountings
11. Top up power steering fluid level
12. Fit new oil filter
13. Engine flush, drain & refill engine oil
14. Inspect front brake pads visually from outside
15. Torque wheel nuts to correct setting
16. Inspect tyres and set tyre pressures
17. Assess brake performance and overall performances of steering and suspension on road test
18. Check for abnormal noises on road test
19. Check operation of heating systems and air conditioning
20. Check operation and condition of seat belts
21. Hand wash and leather
22. Check history of vehicle if available and timing belt interval
23. Inspect brake hoses and pipes
24. Inspect suspension mountings
25. Inspect shock absorbers
26. Inspect drive shaft, joints and gaiters
27. Inspect track rod ends
28. Assess engine performance and oil levels
29. Check clutch for free play
30. Check gear shift quality/auto gearbox operation
31. Check steering for stability, pull or wander
32. Check operation of instruments
33. Fit new spark plugs if applicable
34. Replace pollen filter if applicable
35. Refit road wheels (rotate tyres is required)
36. Fit new air filter
37. Lubricate all doors, locks and hinges
38. Check electric equipment if fitted, central locking, windows, sunroof and mirrors
39. Pressure test cooling system
40. Lubricate linkages and cables
41. Adjust handbrake
42. Check prop shaft and universal joints
43. Inspect fuel tanks for leaks
44. Inspect under body for corrosion
45. Examine steering rack for play and oil leaks
46. Check power steering hoses/pumps for leaks
47. Inspect brake linings front and rear
48. Check wheel bearings and ball joints
49. Top up gearbox oil level
50. Stamp service book if provided
51. Reset service light if applicable
52. Lubricate brake back plates, side points and handbrake levers
53. Ensure caliper operation is normal
54. Top up differential oil
55. Fit new fuel filter
56. Replace brake fluid
57. Change gearbox oil if accessible
58. Adjust tappets if necessary
